Minutes

Middlebush Field, Sunday noon after league sponsored pick-up game. Attending: Cruz-ATeam, Frank-CW and Peter-Allstate.

Items:

- 1. Managers present approved the new manager for A-team, Cruz
- 2. Mario should follow up with an email to the league formally resigning but he will remain on the roster as a player and to assist the manager. Cruz intends to continue introducing himself to the players and developing a roster as well as trying to create a team email group He will try to confirm whether last year's team sponsor will renew his funding for 2023 and recover team equipment from JB.
- 3. League finances--league spent \$135.00 on permits and \$15.00 on lockbox keys last fall and collected \$135.00 from weekly player donations. There is a bank account balance remaining from last year's team-contributions and Element3 monthly credits which totaled \$68.00. The league will need to soon pay for insurance (\$160.00) and field permits (\$750.00). Teams should expect to provide initial funding of at least \$400.00 ASAP.
- Managers present voted to approve the field use schedule so it can be used to request permits from Franklin Township. A suggestion was made to use Williams Field in place of Lower Inman for 2023 because of the evening sun glare but not adopted.
- 5. To reduce expenses, the league will try to use one new game ball and one used ball for each game as much as possible.
- 6. We continue to request a lock box from the town for Middlebush Field.
- 7. Umpires--CW will contact Mike to see if he will umpire again in 2023. Allstate will contact Clay and Skip.
- 8. A season game schedule will be prepared and distributed to managers for approval.
