The family of Frank Green sadly announces his passing on January 4, 2025, at the age of 66 years old, after a lengthy battle with leukemia and lymphoma. He was born in Elizabeth, NJ on November 7, 1958, to Claire Farrell and Robert Green.

He was an exceptional athlete, excelling at soccer and softball as a youth and into adulthood. He played in a 60+ softball league up until he was diagnosed with lymphoma in May of 2024. Frank had a sharp, dry, sarcastic wit, never failed to bring a smile to everyone's face, and had a song for just about everything. He was kind and generous, and would always go out of his way to be empathetic and help anyone in need. As Frank would often say, "What's the point of living if you don't bring a smile to others?".

Frank worked as a machinist for Mulberry Metals in Union, NJ for four years, having previously been employed by RotorClip and Technical Wire Products (Tecknit). He met his wife Sue while working at Tecknit. They married in 1995 and moved to Roselle Park, where they raised their family. Frank was the proud father of his two children, Hunter and Rebecca. He was highly involved in their extracurricular activities; he coached two youth soccer teams and served as the President of the Roselle Park High School Marching Band Parents' Association for two years. He was also a great dog dad to his dog Abby, who will miss him very much. He enjoyed camping and fishing and fell in love with New England, with dreams of retiring on Lake Champlain in Vermont.

He is predeceased by both parents and his older brother, Robert Green. Surviving are his wife, children, and sister-in-law Lee; his three sisters, Diane Montgomery and family, Nancy Moll and family, and Joanne Levitt and family; and younger brother James Green and family, as well as many nieces and nephews, two great-nephews, and a great-niece. Frank will be greatly missed by his family, neighbors, and friends.
