

Joseph Calvin Anthony Straub

JOSEPH CALVIN STRAUB passed away on Saturday, May 20, 2023, at his home surrounded by his wife and daughters. He was 83 years old.

Born in Chicago, IL, to Joseph and Alva (née Bernard). His parents moved the family several times during his childhood. He moved to Kearny, NJ in 1962, before settling down in Monroe Township 51 years ago.

Prior to retiring, he was a tractor trailer driver for Linden Motor Freight in Linden, where he worked for 35 years. Joseph was a U.S. Army Veteran, having served from 1958-1962 as a Specialist 4th Class Sharpshooter.

He was a parishioner of Immaculate Conception R.C. Church in Spotswood since 1972. Joseph was predeceased by his parents.
